Gathering of Information

To use the services provided by AFL Canada & SportingPulse users are required to register as members. Members are required to submit personal information to verify their identities.

Use of Information

Several of our services require a user to provide an email address. The registered email address is used for this purpose. To maintain contact with our users we will periodically send electronic newsletters which contain content believed to be of interest to our membership.

Our email-based services to members operate on an opt-in basis. Recipients have the ability to opt-out at any time from AFL Canada's SportingPulse site or membership communications.

Sharing of information

AFL Canada will not sell, rent, or lease your personally identifiable information to others. AFL Canada may disclose information about our users when we believe, in good faith, that the disclosure is required by law.

Cookies

A cookie is a data file that certain web sites write to your computer's hard drive upon visitation. The AFL Canada SportingPulse website makes use of cookies to provide authentication to our site and to allow the tracking of the logged in status of a user.
